SHORT BIOGRAPHY

I am a physician and psychiatric epidemiologist leading a research program in South Korea focused on elucidating the bidirectional associations between mental health and physical health, especially in the field of depressive disorders, PTSD, and cognitive impairment. I serve as Principal Investigator or Co-Principal Investigator for 13 large population-based research studies funded by more than USD 8 million from the Korean Ministry of Health and Welfare and other national agencies. These large-scale studies require extensive collaborations with researchers in other sectors, such as the Korean Ministry of Health and Welfare, the Korean Statistical Office, the Health Insurance Review & Assessment Service, the Korean Society of Epidemiology, the Korean Society of Psychiatry, and other organizations. In more recent COVID-19 related work, I laid the foundation for a community cohort, querying mental health changes during COVID-19, establishing a prediction model using data from the Korean National Trauma Center and the National Statistical Office, and conducting in-depth analyses of nationally representative data. The proposed study dovetails with my expertise by building prediction models in national level population mental health and implicating cutting-edge epidemiological methods in population big data. If the project is funded, I will contribute data and facilitate data linkage between US and Korea. In summary, I have the expertise, training, leadership, and motivation necessary to contribute to the proposed research project as a Co-Investigator.
